Physical Status

The City has:

- 2,300 lane miles of streets
- 1,120 miles of linear sidewalk
- 150 blocks of pedestrian pathways
- An 85-year resurfacing cycle, which means a street will be resurfaced once in your lifetime
- There are 671 traffic signalized intersections and over 36,000 street lights
- Over 1,000 miles of underground sanitary sewer pipes, including 31,000 structures & 7 pump stations



Physical Status

There are over 640 acres of developed parks, public grounds, plazas and 1,200 acres of open space.



Oakland's watershed is comprised of 15 main creeks, over 30 tributaries, Lake Merritt and the Estuary.

5th by bicycle mode share

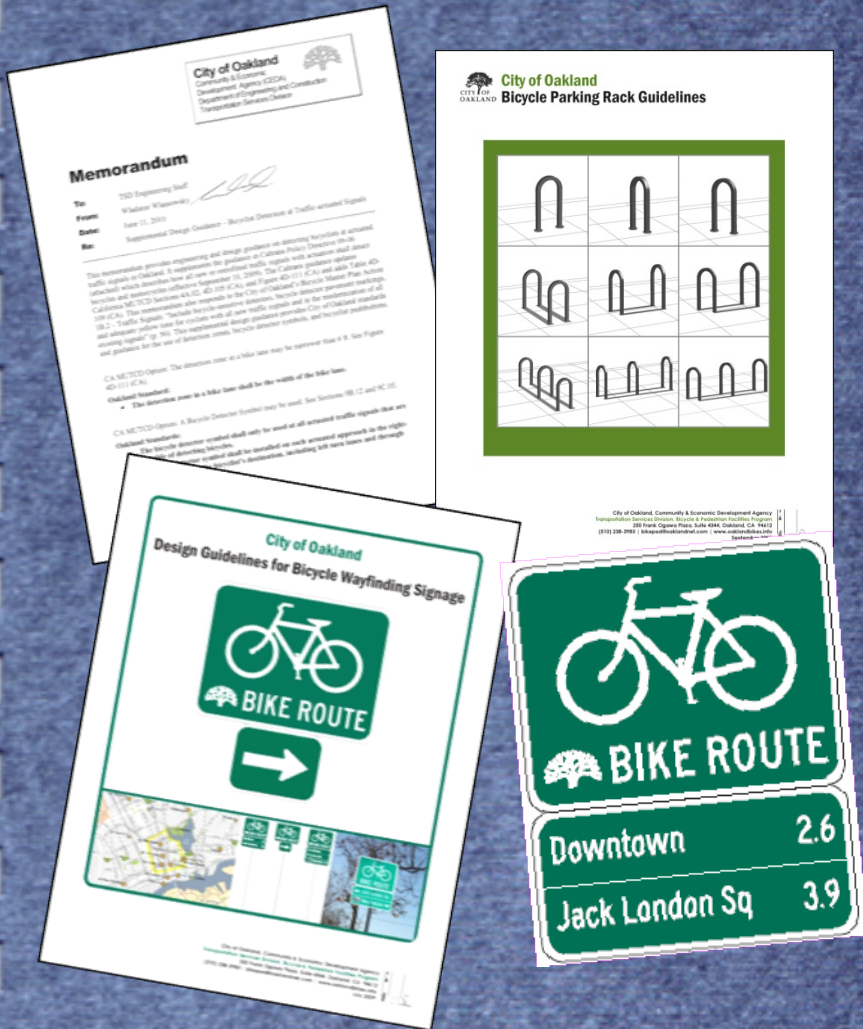
(after Portland, Minneapolis, Seattle, and San Francisco)

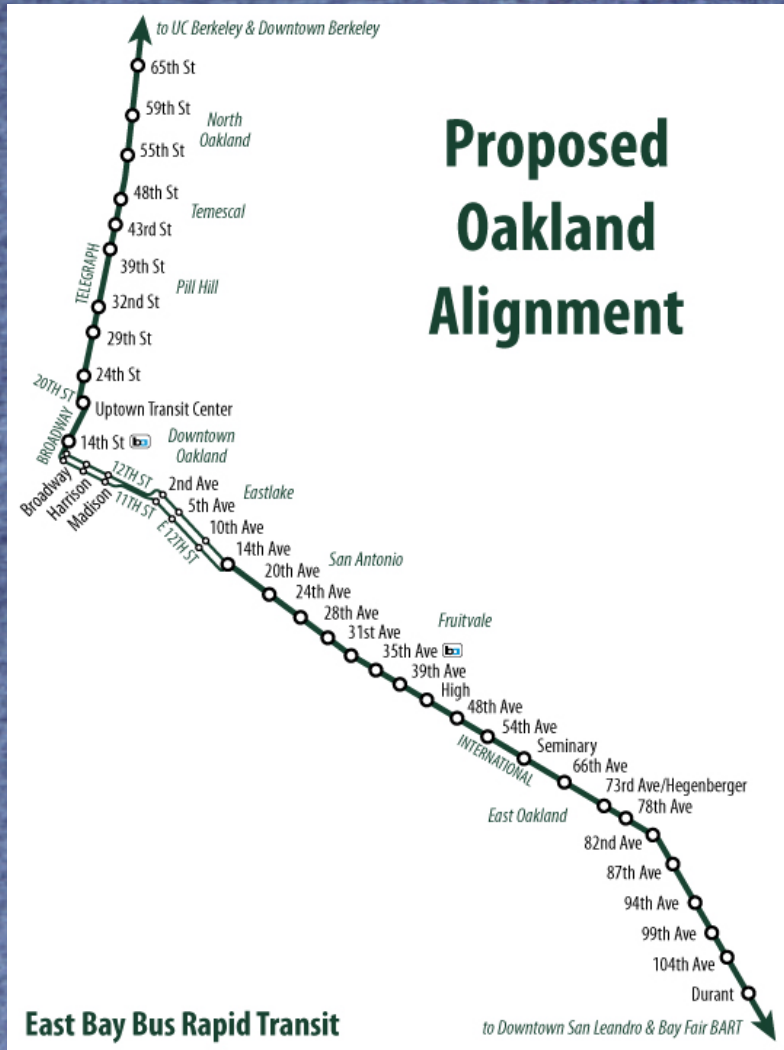
